Applications are invited for the Virtual STRIVE for MORE (Success Through Rewarding, Inclusive Virtual Experiences for Mathematics: Opportunities in Research and Education) Workshop to be held via Zoom on September 25, 2021, 12-5 pm Eastern.

This virtual workshop, co-hosted by faculty and graduate students from Clemson University and Virginia Tech, is part of the MORE series of workshops established in 2019 through funding from the National Science Foundation and the National Security Administration.

The conference objectives are to:

- increase representation of under-represented groups in graduate programs in the mathematical sciences;
- expand peer networks for participants;
- provide success strategies for completion of a graduate degree;
- provide information for career options for students in mathematics and statistics; and
- give insight into the graduate student experience.

The active workshop format engages students in highly relevant mathematics tied to applications that address societal needs.
