Dear Director of Undergraduate Studies,

I am writing to let you know about an opportunity for some of your students from groups historically under-represented in mathematics, who are considering graduate school and would benefit from additional preparation.

The Causeway Postbaccalaureate Certificate Program at Northwestern University is designed for just such students, to help them prepare for study at competitive doctoral programs in the mathematical sciences.

Causeway is a year-long program which provides free tuition and a living stipend (about \$37,000) for its students. The students take a full load of Northwestern courses while receiving considerable mentorship and academic support. Causeway also provides a GRE preparation course, panel discussions on graduate applications, and a regular seminar in which speakers present mathematics and discuss their various personal and professional journeys. Causeway students also can mentor local high-school students. You can read more at this website.
