

NC State Prague: Introduction to Engineering and Problem Solving (E 101)

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The NC State European Center in Prague is NC State's only permanent international facility and welcomes students from all academic disciplines. Students earn NC State credit hours in one of Europe's most beautiful cities. On-site orientation and a city tour are included in the first weeks of the program, allowing students to get to know the city, each other, and NC State Prague staff members. Additional cultural events and excursions are also included in the program to engage students with the historically and culturally rich city of Prague and the Czech Republic.

ACADEMICS

The Engineering Summer Program is six weeks long. Engineering students take E 101: Introduction to Engineering & Problem Solving, an intensive 3-week course with an NC State faculty, and choose one additional 6-week long GEP course. Offered classes are fulfilling GEP requirements of Humanities, Natural Sciences, U.S. Diversity and many more.
